ORDER

In compliance with the Judgment dated 26.3.2010 of Hon' High Court in Writ Petition No.1688/2010, Government approved the Scheme for Referendum and authorised Director of Public Instructions (now, Director of General Education) as the Special Officer (Referendum) for conducting the Referendum as per the orders read above. Therein, Referendum was contemplated with a view to recognise only one organisation for the entire teaching community. Later, it was noticed that Rule 51 and 52 of Chapter XIV C of KER envisage multiple service organisations to exist, as elucidated therein, for each distinct class of staff in Secondary Schools as well as in Primary Schools in School Education Deptt..

- 2) In the above circumstances, taking cognizance of the fact that the GO read above would run contrary to the spirit of Rule 51 and 52 of Chapter XIV C of KER, the Government Order read above is hereby revised to the effect that the Referendum has to be conducted strictly in accordance with the provisions contained in Rule 51 and 52 of Chapter XIV C of Kerala Education Rules.
