Sub: Home Department - High Court Establishment -Special Casual Leave combined with holidays/vacation/ordinary leave can be treated as duty for the purpose of declaration of probation - clarification sought for - reg.

Ref: Your Office Letter No.A6-20/2019 Dated 05.08.2019.

In inviting attention to the reference cited, I am directed to inform you the following:

"Special Casual Leave is not included under the definition of duty as per Rule 2(6) of Part I, KS&SSRs. Hence, special casual leave cannot be counted as duty for the purpose of probation. It is also clarified that the holidays (including vacation) which are prefixed/suffixed/intervened with Special Casual Leave cannot be treated as duty for the purpose of probation as per the said rule".
